

HomeWorks Tri-County Electric Cooperative
Touchstone Energy High School Senior Scholarship Program

Eight one-time scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to high school seniors, based on need, grades, and community service.

Purpose:

- To support cooperative members furthering their higher education;
- To promote the cooperative's involvement with our communities

Timeline:

- Applications are due at our Portland office by 5 pm, **March 15**
- Applications may be mailed to 7973 E Grand River, Portland MI 48875; faxed to 517-647-4856; or emailed to jgraham@homeworks.org as a PDF or in Word (.doc/.docx) format
- Early May – Winners notified so they can plan to attend their district meeting
- Mid-May – Announce at district meetings, with the winners present to be recognized – scholarships will be paid directly to the college once student has registered

Criteria:

Applicant must be a high school senior and U.S. citizen, **whose parents or guardians are currently member-owners of the cooperative**. Preference is given to students whose primary residence lies within HomeWorks Tri-County Electric Cooperative's service area. A "member-owner" purchases electricity from HomeWorks in their own name. (Children of HomeWorks Tri-County employees are also eligible if they meet the membership requirements listed here.)

These scholarships are available to home-schooled students, as well as those enrolled in public or private high schools.

Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited full-time post-secondary credit program (institute, technical, community college, or university) with a program starting date between June 1 and November 30 of this year. (If selected, you will be asked to provide your Social Security Number, as well as copies of your school's official registration information showing your enrollment.)

Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Academic achievements, including grade point average, academic honors and special courses taken, etc. **A transcript is optional, but very helpful.**
- Leadership, extracurricular activities, community service, and work experience
- **A brief applicant-written statement of your need for this scholarship**
- **A brief applicant-written statement of educational and career goals**
- **A recommendation written by a third party**
- Your application must be legible to be considered. Do NOT use pencil. If you fill out the application in your own handwriting, use blue or black ink and be careful to keep your writing neat. Use standard margins on the pages – do not write from one edge of the paper to the other.

A complete application MUST include the basic information sheets (first two pages), the two applicant statements and the third-party recommendation. Incomplete applications will not be considered. *(If time allows, applicants who fail to include all requested information MAY be notified and offered the chance to complete their application.)*
